Dear Parents,

Once again, Martial Arts World is gearing up for an unbelievable Summer Camp and we hope your child will join us! We would like to introduce you to our program and give you plenty of information so you can make an informed decision about your child's plans for the summer. Knowing they will not only be having fun, but feel confident that while you are working, your child is in the hands of people that are well trained and truly care that your children have a constructive, balanced summer day camp experience.

The Martial Arts World Summer Camp program is designed to meet each child's needs based on age appropriate and self-confidence building activities. It is not just about martial arts! (Although we do believe it CAN change lives ©). We call our camp an adventure camp, because they will get to experience so many things. We will have multiple field trips each week, such as bowling, swimming and skating, as well as, motivational Martial Arts classes every day. In addition, we will have exciting theme days that let your child get creative with arts and crafts, music, indoor rock climbing and other sports and interests. Our fees include all of our field trips, activities, arts & crafts and martial arts classes. We offer a 10% sibling discount for families. Our registration fee is \$75 plus tax and that will give your child a package of three T-Shirts, carrying bag, and a water bottle. Your child must wear a Martial Arts World T-shirt every day. You can choose to sign up for 1 week of camp or all 11 weeks of summer.

Summer Camp Program Details



We are excited and prepared to welcome your child to our program. We want to make sure you have all the information and details you need to make an informed decision about our camp. Below is all you need to know to ensure summer fun!

PROFESSIONAL STAFF:

Our dedicated professional staff is focused on providing an exciting and safe environment for all our Summer Camp students. We pride ourselves on creating a structured but fun environment that is geared towards personal growth for each student. All Staff have been through thorough back ground checks, safety and first aid programs and continue to undergo training that will aid us in providing the best care for our students. In addition, our "Junior Counselors" not only add "hands-on-deck" but great role models for our younger students to strive to become. We are proud that all of our Staff, Head Counselors & Junior Counselors are all CPR, First Aid and AED Certified by the American Red Cross.

ITEMS TO BRING EVERY DAY:

Your child must wear their Martial Arts World T-shirt, appropriate shoes and shorts every day. Your child will not be allowed to attend any field trip without a camp T-shirt. This is for safety reasons. Be sure to send your child's martial arts belt in their camp back packs every day. Additional T-shirts are available for purchase if you feel you need an extra. They are \$12.00 plus tax.

We suggest that all students wear comfortable shoes. A good rule of thumb is to wear sneakers every day and pack flip flops on pool days. This will ensure they always have great shoes to explore the nature trails and if a pool day is cancelled, they will always have sneakers for a change in plans! A water bottle and sunscreen are must have items for every day of camp, especially on field trips.

LUNCH & SNACK:

Your child needs to bring a lunch & two snacks every day. Please clearly label your child's lunch boxes. NO Candy or soda is allowed at Martial Arts World. We do not microwave or refrigerate any food, so be sure to send an appropriate lunch & snacks for your child. If your child does not have a lunch, a lunch will be ordered for them and you will be charged \$8.00. It is imperative due to the level of physical fitness of our program that all of our students have a lunch and two snacks.

POOL DAY INFORMATION:

We will be going to Collegiate Aquatics Center on Thursdays. They are located at 5050 Ridgedale Parkway, Richmond, VA 23234. We will be the only students using the pool at the time we are there. On pool days please have your child in their swimsuit with their M.A.W. T-shirt on. Please pack a towel and undergarments for them to change into after swimming. Please provide a zip lock back for their wet bathing suit. Please label any goggles you send for your child. They may only use goggles that have two separate eye pieces like glasses. Goggles that go over their eyes and nose (like the type you wear snorkeling) are not allowed.) Swimwear: There are many styles of swimsuits available. Please understand this is a children's camp and we do not want our children revealing more than they need to. Acceptable Boys Swimwear: Swim Trunks – that fit tightly on the waist. Acceptable Girls Swimwear: One piece swim suits and Tankinis – NO BIKINIS MAY BE WORK AT CAMP

*Please note that if your child does not follow this dress code, they will not be allowed to swim on swim day.

Swim Lessons: Swim Lessons are available from Collegiate every Wednesday for \$15 per child. They will get a ½ hour lesson and then have an hour of free swim. You must sign up ASAP as slots are limited and you must pay in advance. There will be 5 children to one instructor. Payments are non-refundable as we need to pay for Swim Instructors in advance. You must pay in advance for the entire summer your child is attending.

Summer Camp Program Details

LABEL EVERYTHING:

Please note that your child's name should be on everything they bring to the center including clothes and backpacks. Please check the Lost & Found bins regularly for your child's belongings. Unclaimed items will be donated to Goodwill at the end of every month.

CELL PHONES:

Activated Cell phones are not allowed to be used at M.A.W. Please encourage your child to leave them at home or keep them in their bag. If a student needs/wants to contact a parent, we are sensitive to that need and they may ask permission at any time. Non activated Cell phones used for games will only be allowed on bus trips when Electronics are allowed.

SIGN IN/INFORMATION

It is important that you sign your child in and out each day WITH INITIALS at the summer camp table located in the front lobby.

During the summer, please check the table weekly for the SUMMER CAMP NEWSLETTER. This gives you more detailed information about the upcoming weeks events including bus departures times, special events, field trips, or notices from team leaders.

PICK UP & SIGN OUT:

We offer the convenience of calling MAW when you are on your way to pick up your child at the end of the day. This way, we can have your child ready, with sock and shoes on, and bag packed to go home when you arrive. Please note that the Summer Camp Program ends at 6:00 p.m. Please make arrangements to pick your child no later than 6:00 p.m. every day.

Upon entering the Center, your child will be called, and they will join you in the lobby as quickly as possible! Feel free to have a seat in the lobby while waiting for your child to gather his/her belongings. We want your child to impress you with their ability to be responsible for their things. Please be sure to sign your child out on the attendance sheet, with your Initials.

For the safety of all the children in our program, during the operation of the Summer Camp Program, no parents will be allowed past the lobby without a staff escort. This is for the safety for our students.

We love to communicate with our parents. However, during pick up it can be a hectic time. If you have any questions or comments about your child, feel free to email our General Manager at <u>Greeson@mawwestend.com</u>. If further action is needed, we can set up a meeting for a more convenient time.

TUITION, ON TIME PAYMENTS & REGISTRATION FEE:

All accounts are set up on an automatic draft. If you payment declines on the day it was set to draft you must make arrangements to pay online at amsepay.com or here at the school the next business day. Note: all payments taken at school or online manually will have an additional 10% added to them. The Registration Fee you pay for your child is non-refundable and must be paid at the time of registration.

WITHDRAWALS:

We require a two weeks written notice for cancelling an agreement. If you are behind on your payments, you must pay your past due balance before we can cancel your agreement.

ELECTRONICS:

Due to today's advancing technology, there are many games and gadgets that can entertain our children. Please understand that this is an ACTIVE camp. Electronics are allowed on certain days only and we will let you and your child know when those days are. PLEASE LABEL ALL ELECRONICS AND GAMES. We do not give out our Wi-Fi password for the safety of your child. Martial Arts World will not be responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged electronics. **The following devices are not allowed: portable DVD players and laptops.**



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DISCIPLINE POLICY

In order to ensure the all-around success of our programs, we want to make you aware of our discipline policy.

Multiple studies have shown that the ability to discipline one's self and one's behavior is a greater predictor of success, than IQ. Two of our most important goals as Instructors and mentors to your child(ren), is to one, support you in helping them learn acceptable and unacceptable behaviors and two, to guide them in cultivating positive habits and actions. We work to consistently recognize and reward good choices, supporting their peers, great attitudes, and following directions. We do this through verbal praise, special recognition and even occasional prizes. We also work to create consistent, predictable consequences for unacceptable behavior choices. We want to create students that take responsibility for their actions and choices.

UNIFORM:

Failure to bring and dress in full uniform (during summer camp T-shirt and belt), regardless of circumstances, result in the child not being able to participate in pre/post game activities and to temporarily lose their rank in class (although they will continue to practice their belt level curriculum in class).

ON THE VAN/BUS:

We have zero tolerance for misbehavior on the van/bus. This is to ensure the safe ride from our center to and from field trips. If your child displays any disruptive behavior, including, but not limited to: riding without seatbelt, hitting, yelling, kicking, cursing, provoking other students, and/or not following directions, discipline policy will be enforced.

AT THE DOJANG (SCHOOL):

Discipline policy will be enforced for:

- Aggression We have zero tolerance for aggression displayed between students and/or staff.
- Not following directions and/or following school rules.
- "Bullying" types of behaviors, such as threats, continuous name calling or teasing and/or inappropriate language.
- Lying, stealing or disrespectful attitude toward instructors, training instructors, leaders or parents

The following sequence of disciplinary actions will take place:

- 1. <u>Disciplinary Warning</u> Removal of student's belt for up to five days (five days of no disruptiveness) and/or a writing assignment. A conference with parent, upon pick-up that day, will take place, and form signed.
- 2. <u>Disciplinary Suspension</u> Removal from the program for three days; parent will be called immediately to come and pick child up. (This will count as Day one) Form will be signed.
- 3. <u>Disciplinary Dismissal</u> Immediate dismissal from the program (no refunds). We do not apologize for these extreme measures we have zero tolerance for creating an unsafe environment for our other students and staff.

Please review this with your child(ren). Once they are able to communicate a clear understanding of the discipline policy, have them sign the bottom of this sheet along with you.

SECTION III STUDENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement executed on the date shown front by and between **MARTIAL ARTS WORLD OF WEST END**, **INC.** or any of its affiliates, hereinafter referred to as the Center, and the buyer, who has caused his/her signature to be affixed hereto, hereinafter referred to as Enrollee, or Member.

The Center agrees to provide instruction in Martial Arts to the Enrollee during the scheduled instruction hours of the Center. Enrollee understands that it is his or her responsibility to attend instruction sessions. Enrollee understands that the entire course fee stated front is due and payable according to the terms of this agreement whether or not enrollee chooses to attend instructional sessions provided by the Center. In consideration for the Centers promises to instruct and provide instruction facilities, Enrollee agrees and promises to pay the course fees shown on front. In the event of default in the payment of any installment or fee in accordance with the terms above, or a breach of any of the covenants herein contained to be performed by the Enrollee, the balance due under this agreement shall become immediately due and payable.

Enrollee agrees to abide by the rules and regulations governing the conduct and operation of instruction sessions, students, and observers, in order to promote efficiency, safety, and recognition of the instruction certification, as prescribed by the Center. Enrollee acknowledges that the rules and regulations governing the Center have been adopted, and may be changed from time to time, and Enrollee agrees to abide by all such rules and regulations as adopted or hereinafter amended. The hours of operation may be changed at the discretion of the Center. The Center reserves the right to revoke or terminate any membership. Enrollee agrees that all exercises and/or courses are undertaken at Members own risk. The Enrollee understands that the procedures and exercises involved in instruction and participation as explained to him/her by an assistant of the Center. The Enrollee understands that there is a risk of personal injury involved in the course of instruction and with this knowledge agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Center from all losses caused by accident or injury to the Enrollee, or to third persons, who may be with Enrollee of the Center, in the event that either the Enrollee or said third person is injured in any way during the performance and execution of exercises.

The company owning the Center and the agents and employees shall not be responsible for damaged, lost or stolen articles, inside or outside the facility. The Center reserves the right to amend or add to these rules and conditions and to adopt new rules and conditions as it may deem necessary. If an Enrollee desires to transfer his/her membership to another individual, a transfer fee will be assessed to cover our costs which will not exceed \$35.00. Memberships obtained on a special are not transferable or freezable. I, the Enrollee or the Member, irrevocably authorize the Center, its successors and assigns, and those acting under its authority, to copy, use, publish, for art, advertising, trade, or any other lawful purpose whatsoever, photographic portraits, pictures or videotapes of me, in which I may be included in whole or in part. In consideration of the training obtained, I agree that I will not, during the continuance of this agreement, and for a period of five (5) years following termination of my association with the Center, engage in teaching Martial Arts or offering similar training or instruction within a fifty (50) mile radius of any school operated by the Center without the express written authorization of same.

I, the Enrollee of the Member, irrevocably authorize the Center, its successors and assigns, and those acting under its authority, to copy, use, publish, for art, advertising, trade, or any other lawful purpose whatsoever, photographic portraits, pictures or videotapes of me or my child, in which I may be included in whole or in part.
